

At Uddebo Oil Harbour's waste reception facilities, ship-generated waste can be sorted according to the following categories:

Hazardous waste



Batteries
Small batteries



Electronics
Devices with a cord or battery



Paints and solvents
Paint, acetone, thinner, white spirit



Aerosols
Spray cans, paint sprayers, lubricating spray



Light sources
Light bulbs, low energy lamps and LED, small fluorescent tubes (less than 60 cm)



Fluorescent tubes
Fluorescent tubes from 60 cm



Oil filters



Solid oil waste
Oily cottons and rags



Liquid oils
Engine oil, hydraulic oil, transmission oil

Non-hazardous waste



Combustible waste
Note: deposit newspapers, magazines and plastic items (not packaging) here



Scrap metals



Corrugated cardboard
- empty and flattened. Note: deposit paper packages here



Plastic packagings
Plastic bags, cans, bottles, styrofoam



Coloured glass
Bottles, jars



Clear glass
Bottles, jars

Recycling procedures

A manually maneuvered trolley is free for use and available for transport of waste inside the harbour area.

Hazardous waste containers must be tightly closed and permanently marked.

If the waste is inappropriately sorted, the vessel will be invoiced in accordance with the additional costs caused by further waste treatment
