THE PORT OF LULEÅ 24 AUGUSTI 2019



Between 10:00am – 2:00pm on the 24th of August the port of Luleå is open for public. The day festival is free and brings thousands of people together. We welcome you to join us in the celebration of our city's maritime and industrial history. Some really thrilling experiences await you.

- Exhibitions by mining and steel manufacturing companies LKAB and SSAB
- Foods and coffee are available for purchase

PORT FACTS

Port of Luleå is a public harbour which, in spite of its northerly position and thanks to excellent co-operation with modern state-run and locally operated ice-breakers, is open for shipping all the year round.

Within the port area there are four harbour sections: the Victoria Harbour where dry goods are handled, Uddebo for liquid products and the industrial quays of LKAB and Cementa, respectively. The old quay for loading iron ore is used for governmental icebreakers and as a cruise port.

The annual volume of goods handled exceeds seven million tons, principally bulk goods, which confirms Luleå's position as the largest bulk goods port in Sweden and one of the five largest ports in Sweden.
