EFFECTIVE FROM 1 JANUARY 2026, AND UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE.



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2. Terms and conditions

The Port Authority reserves the right to revise the port tariff during the year.

2.1. Fees and Invoicing

2.1.1. The fee is based on GT (Gross Tonnage) according to the 1969 measurement rules, unless otherwise stated in the tariff. When a vessel calls at Luleå Port for the first time, or if the vessel has been rebuilt since its last call, a valid measurement certificate according to the 1969 rules must be presented by the shipping company or its agent.

2.1.2. The prices listed below are stated in SEK and apply to a complete call, i.e., for arrival and departure to and from the port area.

2.1.3. Advance payment may apply. Luleå Port AB reserves the right to require a bank guarantee.

2.1.4. Each cargo order is subject to a port infrastructure fee.

Each discharge from, or loading to, another vessel – so-called *ship-to-ship operations* – within the VTS area is also subject to a port infrastructure fee.

Examples:

For ship-to-ship operations, this means:

- Scenario 1: The vessel performs 2 ship-to-ship operations → 2 port infrastructure fees
- Scenario 2: The vessel performs 2 ship-to-ship operations + one outgoing cargo order → 3 port infrastructure fees

For shifting operations, this means:

- Scenario 3: The vessel discharges an incoming cargo order + shifts to another quay to load an outgoing cargo order → 2 port infrastructure fee
- Scenario 4: The vessel discharges an incoming cargo order + shifts along the same quay to load an outgoing cargo order → 1,5 port infrastructure fee

2.1.5. Vessels passing through the port area are charged half the fee.

2.1.6. For commercial vessels calling at the port without embarking or disembarking passengers or cargo, a half port due is charged if the stay is less than 24 hours. If the stay exceeds 24 hours, the full fee is applied. After one day, a berthage fee is charged according to the vessel type and berth used.

2.1.7. **Environmental discounts** are granted provided registration is completed in accordance with the rules for ESI (www.environmentalshipindex.org) or CSI (cleanshippingindex.com).

2.1.8. Vessels with at least 30 points under ESI or a minimum of 4 stars under CSI receive a 5% discount on vessel fees based on GT.

2.1.9. Vessels certified under Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) 2022/91 are granted a discount of 0.05 SEK per GT on waste management fees upon presentation of the certificate.

2.1.10. Notification of registration and compliance with the above conditions must be submitted via email to portcontrol@portlulea.com.

Waste

2.1.11. Delivery of sludge must be ordered no later than 24 hours prior to the vessel's arrival according with instruction on port website and with portcontrol@portlulea.com in copy. Uncanceled deliveries will be invoiced.

2.1.12. The waste management fee covers the costs for normal waste quantities. LHAB reserves the right to charge additional special costs beyond the normal amounts.

2.1.13. An additional charge will be applied for the extra costs incurred by Luleå Port AB, or its contractor, if:

- The "notification of waste delivery from vessels" is not made on time according to Swedish law and Luleå Port AB's regulations, or significantly deviates from the actual inspection.
- The waste/sludge contains foreign substances, solvents, or detergents.
- The waste does not originate from the vessel's normal operations.
- Drums and containers with oil residues or hazardous waste are not correctly packed and labeled with their contents.
- If delivery and storage do not occur in designated areas.
- Delivery does not take place at the agreed time.
- The vessel does not provide personnel for sludge delivery.
- The pump capacity for sludge is less than 5 m³ per hour.

3.4. Environmental Discounts

3.4.2. Vessels with at least 30 points under ESI or at least 4 stars under CSI will receive a 5% discount on the vessel fee based on GT.

3.4.3. Vessels certified under Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) 2022/91 will receive a discount of 0.05 SEK per GT on waste management fees upon presentation of the certificate

3.4.4. Notification of registration and compliance with the above conditions must be submitted via email to portcontrol@portlulea.com.

3.8. Winter Surcharge

3.9. Exemptions from Cargo Fees

3.9.1. Goods or equipment for the vessel's own needs, such as fuel, provisions, and supplies, as well as containers, platforms, and load carriers

3.10. Special Provisions

3.10.1. For goods handled within the port area but not over the quay, the same fee applies as for goods handled over the quay.

3.13.5. Cancellation

The rate applies regardless of the number of crew members, except in cases of cancellation and waiting time.

5.8.3. Towing of Cruise ships

Towing along the quay is considered an arrival. Towing from one quay to another is considered both a departure and an arrival.

5.8.4. Overtime

From Monday to Friday, 14:30–06:00, as well as on Saturdays and Sundays, an additional charge of 100% is applied to the above base rate.

5.8.5. Waiting time

Waiting time occurs when the arrival/departure time is changed to less than two hours before arrival/departure. Waiting time exceeding 30 minutes is charged as follows:

Cancellation

In case of cancellation after the boatmen have arrived at the quay, a fee of two hours of waiting time per person will be charged.

5.9. Cancellation Policy for Cruise Ship Calls

Late cancellation of a port call will incur the following charges:

- **Less than 14 days before the call** – The passenger fee will be charged. (This is currently stated in the tariff)

- **Less than 7 days before the call** – 20% of the port call fee will be charged.
- **Less than 72 hours before the call** – 75% of the port call fee will be charged.
- **Less than 24 hours before the call** – The full port call fee will be charged.

The port call fee includes both the port infrastructure fee and the passenger fee.

5.9.1. Adjustments to Arrival and Departure Times

If an adjustment of the ETA (Estimated Time of Arrival) at the quay or the ETS (Estimated Time of Sailing) involves a change of more than three (3) hours and is made less than 48 hours before the original time, we reserve the right to charge the following costs:

- Actual costs for booked boatmen.
- Administrative fee: SEK 900.
- Actual costs for security personnel, barriers, or other additional resources already booked or affected by the change

6. Other vessels

"Other vessels" refers to vessels that are not categorized according to the previous sections.

6.1. Naval vessels and other classified vessels.

For cargo hold cleaning waste, ship generated liquid wastes and other waste, the actual cost will be charged. For other services actual cost will be charged.

7. Exemptions from Port Infrastructure Fee

This exemption applies only to vessels calling at quays where the port has operational control or a valid permit. Other quays are not covered by these regulations.

7.1. Vessels Exempt from Fees Include:

7.1.1. The following types of vessels are exempt from vessel fees, provided they call at quays where the port holds operational permits:

1. **Rescue and Pilot Vessels**
Vessels used for maritime rescue or pilotage services.
2. **Customs and Fisheries Vessels**
Government or municipal vessels used for customs inspection or fisheries monitoring.
3. **Icebreakers**
Vessels performing icebreaking services to maintain navigational routes.

4. **Port-Owned Vessels**

Vessels owned by the port or used for port operations.

5. **Vessels without Cargo or Passengers**

Vessels that do not transport cargo or passengers and whose stay does not exceed 24 hours.

6. **Emergency or Repair Stops**

Vessels calling at the port due to emergencies, weather conditions, or safety-critical repairs (not planned inspections).

7.1.2. Conditions:

Time Limit: The exemption applies only for stays of less than 24 hours. After 24 hours, a laytime fee is charged.

Service Fees: Waste handling or other services are charged separately at cost price.

8. Track Fee

1. Sea borne cargo

For goods arriving at or departing from the port by railway, a fee at

3,30 SEK/ton

2. Non sea borne cargo

For non-sea-borne goods that traffic Luleå Port's railway tracks and are not charged in another way, at

470 SEK/Railway wagon
